
The Mirror glossary

Reflection

attitudes, beliefs, and dispositions toward learning




Insights

data points produced by Mirror that help teachers develop a deeper and more accurate understanding of their students through their reflections




Feedback

after reflection, Mirror immediately identifies areas where participants can focus their efforts to deepen their understanding



Objective

specific learning goals or outcomes a teacher wants their students to achieve



Focus

specific lens or framework a teacher wants their students to reflect on their learning (e.g. SEL, Depth of Knowledge, 21st Century Skills)



Engagement

a student mindset that is ready to absorb new information or experiences
